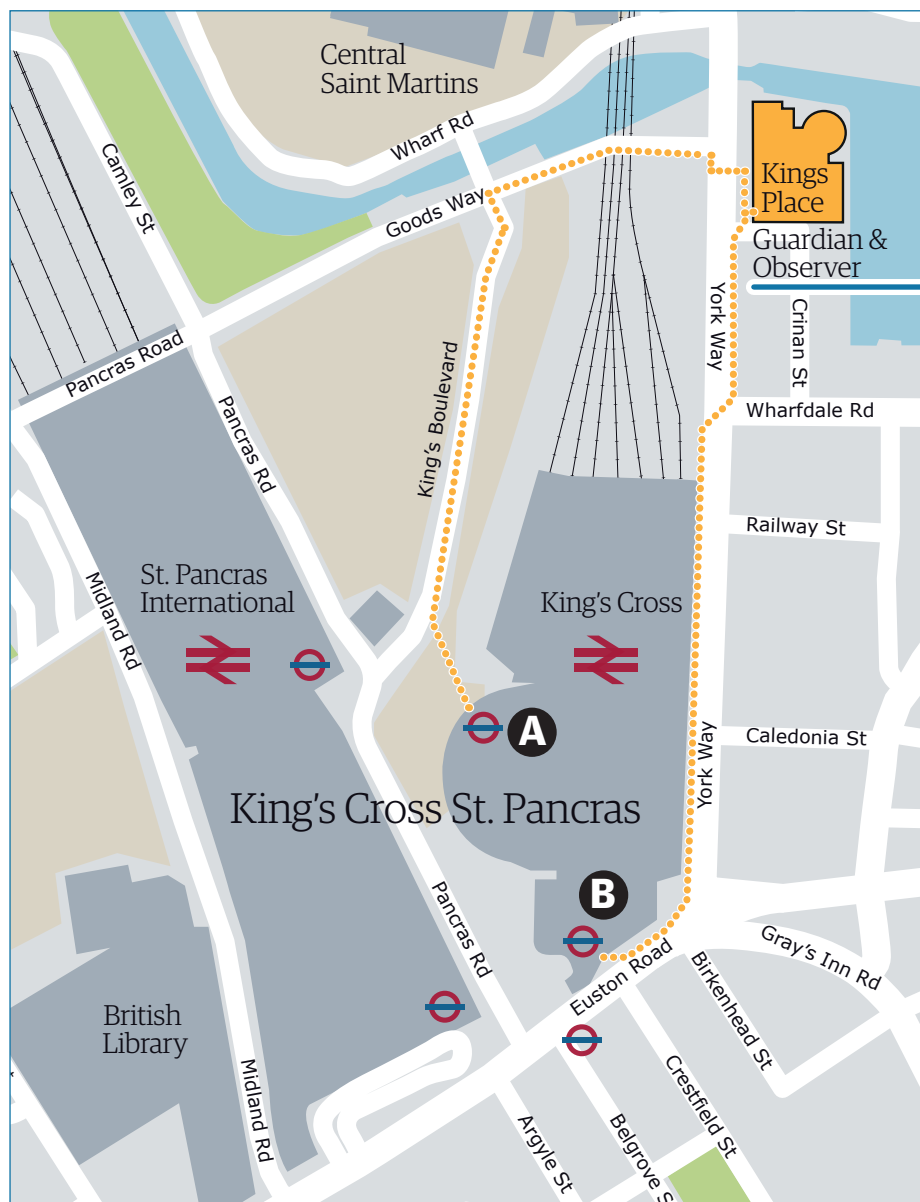


Behind the Headlines

Education Centre

Kings Place, 90 York Way, London N1 9GU



With King's Cross and St Pancras stations serving rail, tube* and bus** services from all over, Kings Place is well located for public transport.



The Guardian and Observer entrance is on the corner of York Way and Crinan Street. Do not use the main entrance to Kings Place Arts Centre.

There is no coach drop off point in the near vicinity (Crinan Street is unsuitable). It is the responsibility of your coach company to find a safe drop off point near by.

There are two ways to walk to the Centre from the station; leave via the **Regent's Canal** exit (A) and proceed along **King's Boulevard** (pedestrian only) and **Goods Way** or from the **Euston Road** exit (B) along **York Way** (crossing with lights)

** Bus: 10, 17, 30, 45, 46, 59, 73, 91, 205, 214, 259, 390, 476
